

## JOHN R. MANSON – CARL ROBINSON AWARD

## **2025 NOMINATION**

The Scholarship and Awards Committee is honored to select the recipient for the 41<sup>st</sup> annual John R. Manson – Carl Robinson Award.

This award honors an individual who has made a significant contribution to the field of Criminal Justice within the New England area. The award is named for two outstanding New England professionals.

John R. Manson served the State of Connecticut as Commissioner of Corrections until his death in 1983. He had a long and distinguished career and was credited with initiating major reforms in the State's prison system.

Carl Robinson was also a pioneer in prison reform in the State of Connecticut, where he served as Warden of Somers State Prison. In 1982, the A.C.A. honored him as the "National Warden of the Year".
