2024 NOMINATION <u>for</u> JOHN R. MANSON – CARL ROBINSON AWARD

The NECCD will select the recipient for the 36^h annual **John R. Manson – Carl Robinson Award.**

This award honors an individual who has made a significant contribution to the field of Criminal Justice within the New England area. The award is named for two outstanding New England professionals:

John R. Manson served the State of Connecticut as Commissioner of Corrections until his death in 1983. He had a long and distinguished career and was credited with initiating major reforms in the State's prison system.

Carl Robinson was also a pioneer in prison reform in Connecticut, where he served as Warden of Somers State Prison. In 1982, the A.C.A. honored him as the "National Warden of the Year."
