2025 Bylaws changes proposals

ARTICLE IX

- A. <u>Awards and Scholarship Committee</u> shall award at the Annual Training Institute the following:
 - 1. **John R. Manson Carl Robinson Award** for outstanding contribution in the field of criminal justice in the New England area.
 - 2. **Angelo R. Musto Award** to an active or retired member of NECCD who has made an outstanding contribution to the organization.
 - 3. John H. Lorenzen Award is awarded to a member, or immediate family of a member, for at least the prior two years. Preference given to applicants who are matriculated in a recognized institution of higher learning with a degree path undergraduate degree. If there are no qualified undergraduate applicants, the Scholarship and Award Committee may consider awarding scholarship(s) to a graduate student applicant. Preference will be given to those going into the field of public service. If there are applicants going into other fields, the committee may consider awarding scholarship(s) to applicants pursuing other disciplines. Prior award recipients cannot reapply.
 - 4. Andrew R. Cannon Scholarship & Achievement Award (ARC) is awarded to a member, or immediate family of a member, for at least the prior two years to those students who have exhibited excellence in the areas of academic achievement and service to their communities. ARC recipients must exhibit characteristics/values that embody a positive and determined attitude, a deep sense of respect and compassion for their community, and a responsibility to serve. Preference is given to applicants who are enrolled full-time at an accredited college, enrolled in a four-year degree program, and a New England resident or attending a college in New England. If there are no qualified undergraduate applicants, the Scholarship and Award Committee may consider awarding scholarship(s) to a graduate student applicant. Preference will be given to those going into the field of public service. If there are applicants going into other fields, the committee may consider awarding scholarship(s) to applicants pursuing other disciplines. Prior award recipients cannot apply.
